NOTICE: Sections of Upper Jordan Fire Trail to be closed 7:30 am - 4:00 pm Monday, November 3, 2025 - approximately Friday, December 12, 2025

Trail not closed on Sundays

This trail closure supports wildfire fuel mitigation in the Field Station for Behavioral Research (FSBR) owned by the University of California, Berkeley. Project activities will take place within FSBR and outside FSBR along Upper Jordan Trail. Total treatment area is approximately 14 acres.

The project goal is to support safe emergency evacuation and emergency access, and create defensible spaces inside the facility. Currently there are numerous trees and shrubby fuels near buildings and roads that are critical fire risks to people and property. Trees can also fall and block traffic during emergencies. Treatments are designed to convert existing fire-prone trees and dead underbrush with more naturally fire resilient vegetation that will then be maintained over time. Most native trees and shrubs will be retained and pruned as needed.

This work is part of other ongoing fire management plan implementation activities in the Hill Campus.
